A Message From the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery:

Did you know Arkansas ranks next-to-last of the 50 states in percentage of adults with college degrees? Did you know Gov. Mike Beebe has set the goal of doubling the number of college graduates in the state by 2025?

You've surely heard of the El Dorado
Promise, which pays college tuition and
fees for graduates of El Dorado High
School through an endowment provided
by Murphy Oil? Five years in, more than
\$8.5 million has been awarded to more
than 1,000 high school graduates in El
Dorado. Nearly 90 percent of EDHS
graduates go on to college.

We were interested to learn that a similar project has launched in Arkadelphia, with the Ross Foundation and Southern Bancorp joining forces to provide funds for students at Arkadelphia High School to supplement the lottery-funded Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship. In the first year of the Arkadelphia Promise, the number of college-bound students rose to 74 percent.

In both Arkansas towns, test scores are rising, more students are taking college-placement tests and school enrollments are up. And this is true in other parts of Arkansas — it is an exciting time to be a college-bound student in the state. Together, we can make a difference and improve Arkansas!



The current owners have had the store for about a year, but Lake Ouachita One Stop has long been a fixture in Mount Ida, with its beginnings as a gas station more than 40 years ago.

favorite thing about the lottery:

Favorite game for customers:

"Spicy Cash and Cash Bonus Bingo are the store's best-sellers," she said.

store specialty:

Worms, crickets, night crawlers, cut shad, chicken livers and "Belgium" worms for hungry fish; canned goods, sausage biscuits and Philly cheese steak sandwiches for hungry humans. There are hand-carved tobacco pipes and hand-crafted McCoy knives, made right in Mount Ida. There's also Native American-style art, belt buckles and drums. There's fishing, camping and hunting gear – everything from minnow buckets to deer attractant. Need some chainsaw art or dustpans made from old license plates? Lake Ouachita One-Stop has you covered. This being Mount Ida, there are some of the area's famous crystals for sale, too. And, perhaps best of all, the store has a large table at its center where locals gather to eat, drink, smoke, swap stories and scratch their lottery tickets.
