## Donnie Miller knows how to sell lottery products.

"Lottery is important to our business," said Donnie Miller who owns 14 convenience stores in six Arkansas towns. "Lottery is just another category for us, but we know how to merchandise. You have to know how to present the lottery products. They need to be front and center and always stocked. Tickets sell themselves if they are visible. The boxes have to be full because that's what catches someone's eye - the colors, the sparkle - and they pop."

"The area should be clean, and of course, you need promotions and advertising in the store. Lottery has been nothing but absolutely positive for my stores. It drives business inside the stores. Less than 5 percent of our customers actually come inside the store. However, you have to come in to buy lottery, so that helps get them inside the door."

Miller agreed to have his manager, Marita West, and assistant manager, Dana Whitfield, sell lottery products at the recent Food Truck Festival in downtown Little Rock. West and Whitfield run Panthers Station in Greenbrier.

"I selected Marita and Dana for the festival because they are two of my best employees, and they understand lottery," Miller said. "To be a salesman you have to talk about your product, be able to explain it and relate to your customer. These two ladies have the knowledge to sell and understand how important it is to our business. It is volume driven."

West and Whitfield sold \$4,300 in lottery products at the Food Truck Festival, and Miller thanked them by giving all the profit to them. He said the minute the jackpot sign went up at the festival, draw game sales started instantly. He added that if retailers don't have a working jackpot sign, they should call their lottery sales rep.

"They did the work, and it gave them some extra money. Customers don't care who owns the store, but they do care about how they are treated. We have to treat customers like guests and take care of them. Marita and Dana do that every day," Miller said.
