A Message from Ernie Passailaigue

Dear Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Retailer:

How is the month going for you and your business? Here in Little Rock at the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery, we're enjoying the autumn season and looking forward to one of the most beautiful months the state of Arkansas offers – November. It's a time for giving thanks, and we at the ASL certainly have plenty for which to be thankful.

We're excited to hear that colleges across the state are reporting increasing enrollment figures this fall -- sometimes even record-breaking enrollment. A September University of Arkansas at Fayetteville news release announced the school's largest numerical increase in enrollment in 64 years. The release also stated that "The Arkansas Challenge Scholarships, funded [in part] by the Arkansas [Scholarship] Lottery, appear to have had a significant impact on University of Arkansas students. More than 4,000 students received Challenge scholarships; over 1,800 of these are new freshmen, 583 received the scholarship last year and will receive it again this year, 300 are non-traditional students and nearly 1,300 are Current Achievers, students who were enrolled in the University of Arkansas last year."

This is but one university in the state's example, but other places of higher learning across Arkansas are experiencing similar rises in enrollment. Many are giving credit to the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery, but I would like to pass most of this credit and goodwill on to you, the lottery retailer. As I've said many times before, we couldn't do it without you! Happy Thanksgiving!


