LANDLORD APPROVAL FOR THE INSTALLATION OF LOTTERY GAMING COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT

Lottery Retailers with a lease agreement must have their landlord's approval for the Lottery's Online Gaming Vendor or its authorized installer to install communications equipment on the roof or building and to run cables.

Prior to installation of an Office of the Arkansas Lottery (OAL) Online Terminal in the retailer's location, the OAL Online Vendor or its authorized installer may need to install a satellite dish or radio antenna on the building or on the building's roof. In most cases and wherever possible, the installer will use non-penetrating mounts to secure the dish or antenna. The installer will use cabling to connect the outdoor equipment to an indoor receiver unit. Whenever possible, the installer will use existing holes in the building to run cables. If it is necessary to drill a hole in the building, the installer will ask for permission from the retailer. For further information, you may request OAL Online Terminal System specifications, Certificate of Liability Insurance, and a letter concerning the use of non-penetrating roof mounts.
