\$20 NEON 200X ADDS ANOTHER WINNER

MORE THAN FIFTY \$50,000 PRIZES REMAIN

LITTLE ROCK— Another Neon 200X top prize winner has claimed a \$50,000 prize! The twentyninth and latest Neon 200X winner is Kardi Jetullahu of Fort Smith, who claimed his prize yesterday. Mr. Jetullahu said he first told his wife he'd won, and was going to pay bills with the winnings. The winning ticket was sold at Flash Market #186, 1601 Rogers Ave., in Fort Smith. The retailer will receive a 1% commission on the sale.

About \$20 Neon 200X

Neon 200X is a \$20 instant game from the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery that launched August 30 loaded with more than eighty \$50,000 top prizes. Fifty-two \$50,000 top prizes remain to be claimed in this game. Neon 200X has more than \$17 million in cash prizes remaining – including \$2.6 million in \$50,000 top prizes. Top prize odds for Neon 200X are 1 in 19,259; overall odds are 1 in 3.13. (The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery is unable to determine how many winning tickets are lost or purchased but still remain unclaimed. Prizes remaining are updated daily.)

About the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery

More than 92 cents of every dollar of Lottery revenue goes to prizes, scholarships, retailer commissions and other expenses in Arkansas. Since Lottery sales started in 2009, the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery has provided nearly \$700 million for in-state college scholarships to Arkansas students, nearly \$2 billion in prizes to players and nearly \$175 million in commissions to Lottery retailers.
