BAXTER COUNTY RESIDENT WINS \$200,022 POWERBALL PRIZE

Randy Worlow of Henderson (Baxter County) today claimed a prize of \$200,022 at the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Jonesboro Claim Center. Mr. Worlow won the prize on a Powerball ticket purchased at the Holiday Hills Grocery in Elizabeth, also in Baxter County. Photos of Mr. Worlow are attached.

He won the huge prize by correctly picking the numbers on the five white balls chosen Saturday night, October 16. Had he purchased the \$1 PowerPlay option with his ticket, his prize would have been \$1,000,000.

He said he told his wife first about the win. When asked what he planned to do with his prize, he said he would give a part to several churches and put the rest in the bank.

All prizes of \$5,000 or higher are subject to withholding for state tax of 7 per cent and federal tax of 25 per cent. The Lottery's only purpose is to provide scholarships and grants to Arkansas residents enrolled in public and private nonprofit two-year and four-year colleges and universities within the state. At the end of June 2010, the ASL reported net proceeds for college scholarships that exceeded \$82 million.
