Second \$1 Million Lottery Prize Won in a Week

Mega Millions Ticket for Friday's Drawing Sold in Pine Bluff

July 12, 2022

LITTLE ROCK – A \$1 million Mega Millions® prize was won in Friday night's drawing – the second in a week. The winning ticket was sold at Super 1 Foods, 2800 Hazel in Pine Bluff.

The winning numbers were 20, 36, 61, 62 and 69. The player matched the five white balls, but not the Megaball® number 20.

Other Mega Millions winners from Friday include two \$1,500 prizes won from Glenwood and Bentonville and five \$600 prizes from El Dorado, Little Rock, Cabot, Springdale and Sheridan.

Today a player from Clark County claimed a \$1 million Mega Millions prize won from the July 1 drawing. The winning ticket was sold at the Road Runner, 23190 Interstate 30 in Bryant.

The Mega Millions jackpot for tonight's drawing has climbed to \$440 million.

"This is the second \$1 million Mega Millions ticket sold in Arkansas over the past 10 days," said Eric Hagler, executive director of the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery (ASL). "I urge all players to check their numbers to see if they're the big winner."

Winners have 180 days from the lottery game drawing date to claim their prize. Any prize of \$500 or less can be claimed at local lottery retailers. Any prize over \$500 must be claimed at the ASL Claim Center in Little Rock in person or by mail.

Retailers receive a 1 percent commission from the sale of winning lottery products, which means the Road Runner in Bryant will receive \$10,000 commission for selling the winning \$1 million Mega Millions ticket. The Super 1 Foods in Pine Bluff will receive the same amount of commission once that winner claims his prize.

About the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery

More than 92 cents of every dollar of ASL revenue goes to prizes, scholarships, retailer commissions and other expenses in Arkansas. Since 2009, the lottery has raised more than \$1.1 billion in proceeds for scholarships. More than 650,000 college scholarships have been awarded to Arkansans. The lottery has awarded more than \$4 billion in prizes to players, about \$349 million in retailer commissions and provided more than \$154 million in state and federal tax revenue.
