"I thought Bart was telling some kind of bad joke," Kelley said when Lambert told him the awesome news. "It seemed so unreal! I had to take advantage of the opportunity to visit the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Claim Center along with my friend. My parents, Edwin and Evelyn also had to accompany us on this trip.

Lambert plans to pay bills and have some fun with his winnings.
