Natural State Jackpot Rises to \$360,000

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — The Natural State Jackpot (NSJ) continued to climb over New Year's weekend, reaching \$360,000 for tonight's drawing.

The game's jackpot was previously won at \$240,000 and split evenly between two winners, both of whom had matched all five winning numbers.

NSJ is an Arkansas-exclusive game with drawings held daily at 8 p.m. Tickets cost \$1 per play, and ticket sales cut off at 7:59 p.m.

Once won, the jackpot resets to \$50,000, then increases by \$5,000 every draw until it reaches \$100,000. After that, it increases by \$10,000 with each draw. Winners have 180 days from the draw date to claim their prizes.

Players must be at least 18 years old to purchase a lottery ticket.
