NLR PLAYER WINS \$100,000 PLAYING MONEY MULTIPLIER SCRATCH-OFF GAME

LITTLE ROCK— Bessie Dexter of North Little Rock became a \$100,000 top prize winner playing the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery's \$5 scratch-off game, Money Multiplier, Friday. In her winner's statement, Dexter said she is going to help her children, pay some bills, and save the rest of her prize. The winning ticket was sold at ASL retailer Si Si Mart, 2500 Highway 161, in North Little Rock, which will receive a 1 percent commission on the prize for selling the winner.

Money Multiplier is a \$5 instant game from the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery, having launched on June 28. With 1 in 3.65 overall odds of winning, an estimated more than \$2.8 million in prizes ranging from \$5 to \$100,000 remain on this game. (All prizes remaining are estimated according to winning tickets that have already been claimed. The ASL cannot determine how many winning tickets may be lost or purchased but as of yet remain unclaimed. All win combinations for each prize amount have been combined into the same prize tier row. Prizes remaining are updated daily.)
