Powerball Jackpot Rises to \$930 Million

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — The Powerball® jackpot rises to \$930 million ahead of tonight's drawing.

Nearing \$1 billion, this jackpot is the draw game's second-highest jackpot of the year and the seventh-largest of all time. The Powerball jackpot was last won for \$1.787 billion in September.

This year, twenty Arkansas lottery players have won prizes of \$500 or greater, with seven of them winning at least \$50,000.

Powerball drawings are held every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. To win the jackpot, a player must match all six winning numbers drawn. Other prizes are available for players who match at least the Powerball number.

Tickets cost \$2 per play, and ticket sales cut off at 8:59 p.m. on the night of the drawing. For an additional \$1, players can add the optional Power Play® multiplier to increase non-jackpot winnings by 2, 3, 4, 5 or 10 times. Players can win up to \$2 million with this multiplier.

Powerball tickets are available for purchase at licensed Arkansas lottery retailers and through retailer apps from ASL's Play on the Go partners. For more information about the Play on the Go options, visit the Where To Play page on the ASL website.
