Powerball Results Delayed

June 10, 2021

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. – The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery announced today the Powerball® drawing from last night is complete and the winning numbers have been posted on the Powerball and Arkansas Scholarship Lottery websites. However, due to technical difficulties in another state, payouts for Wednesday's Powerball drawing are delayed.

There has been a delay in finalizing the draw results that will allow the jackpot for the next drawing to be calculated and winning tickets to be paid.

ASL Executive Director Eric Hagler said while the majority of jurisdictions, including Arkansas, were able to verify the number of winners in each prize tier quickly, additional processing time was required for one jurisdiction.

"We apologize for the delay in delivering the information to the public, but the additional time enables us to ensure that we are reporting the official and verified number of prize winners. Please hold on to your tickets, and we will let you know when retailers are able to pay claims on winning tickets from the June 9, 2021, drawing," Hagler said.

About the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery

More than 92 cents of every dollar of ASL revenue goes to prizes, scholarships, retailer commissions, and other expenses in Arkansas. Since 2009, the lottery has raised more than \$1 billion in proceeds for scholarships. More than 6500,000 college scholarships have been awarded to Arkansans. The lottery has awarded more than \$3.6 billion in prizes to players, about \$315 million in retailer commissions and provided more than \$145 million in state and federal tax revenue.
