

Remington Arms Co-Workers Pocket \$40,000 Mega Millions Prize (See PHOTO)

LITTLE ROCK (January 15, 2013) -- Daniel Pinkerton of DeValls Bluff and Allean White of England (photo attached), both employees of Remington Arms Company in Lonoke, this morning claimed a Mega Millions prize of \$40,000 to share.

The ticket was purchased at Shell Food Mart on Main Street in England. The two co-workers are the remaining members of a workplace lottery group (dubbed the Remington Lottery Group), which started with 5 co-workers three years ago at Remington Arms. Office lottery pools are a fun and economical way to play, and this one really worked out for Daniel and Allean.

To win, the two bought a \$1 Mega Millions ticket that correctly matched four of the five whiteball numbers (1 to 56) as well as the Megaball number (1 to 46), producing a \$10,000 prize. They wisely added the \$1 Megaplier, which multiplied their prize to \$40,000.

Daniel said he plans to buy a new vehicle, and Allean will pay off her vehicle and take care of other financial matters.
