## SECOND NEON 200X WINNER IS FROM LAWRENCE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK— Margaret Piatz of Walnut Ridge is the second \$50,000 top prize winner playing Neon 200X, the new \$20 instant game from the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery. Seventy-nine \$50,000 top prizes remain to be claimed in this game. The winning ticket was sold at ASL retailer Casey's General Store #3287, 2920 S. Caraway Road, in Jonesboro, which will receive a 1 percent commission on the ticket sale. In her winner's statement, Piatz said she bought three 200X tickets. She first told her husband about the win, and she said she and he were praying for a windfall. They plan to put the prize toward paying bills and getting reliable transportation.

## About \$20 Neon 200X

Neon 200X has more than \$24 million in cash prizes – including more than \$4 million in \$50,000 top prizes. Top prize odds for Neon 200X are 1 in 19,259; overall odds are 1 in 3.13. (The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery is unable to determine how many winning tickets are lost or purchased but still remain unclaimed. Prizes remaining are updated daily.) The Arkansas Scholarship Lottery launched \$20 Neon 200X – in a launch that included \$5 Diamond Doubler, \$2 Super 7-11-21, and \$1 5X The Bucks – on August 30.
