Tonight's Powerball Jackpot Jumps to \$484 Million

March 26, 2025

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — The Powerball® jackpot is on the rise, jumping to \$484 million for tonight's draw.

Powerball is a multi-state jackpot game. Nine Arkansans have claimed Powerball prizes of \$50,000 and above since July 2024. The most recent claimant collected their \$100,000 prize in February 2025.

Powerball drawings occur every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 9:59 p.m.

Five white balls numbered between 1 and 69 and one Powerball numbered between 1 and 26 are drawn. To win the jackpot, a player must match all six numbers. Alternative prizes are available for players who match at least the Powerball number.

Powerball tickets cost \$2 per play, and ticket sales cut off at 8:59 p.m. the night of the drawing. For an additional \$1, players can purchase the optional Power Play® multiplier, which will multiply non-jackpot winnings by 2, 3, 4, 5 or 10 times. Players who match the five white balls without the Powerball number can win up to \$2 million.
